There is a sink with a food prep area and electricity inside the shelter. Also, an outdoor, park style charcoal grill for cooking. The rental fee for the shelter gives the club the use of the shelter for the entire day should any members wish to use the shelter earlier. Restrooms are located by the Rotary Pavilion. Picnic set-up will begin around 4:00 p.m., and members should arrive around 5:00 so that we can eat at 6:00. John Fair will bring name tags/markers.

- A) The club will provide drinks, hot dogs, hamburgers, buns, charcoal, and table service (plates, napkins, and utensils). This is a potluck supper, so members are asked to bring a dish to share. CUE does not have tongs, serving spoons or forks for us to use at the picnic. If you bring a dessert or dish, please supply a serving utensil. Chips, pretzels, dips, cut veggies, and the like are fine. Alcohol of any type is not allowed at the park.
